## General Board Meeting

- I. Tammy Ebert called the meeting to order at 11:54 a.m.
- II. General Meeting minutes from 2016 meeting were distributed and read. Sam Evers motioned for approval of the minutes and Eddie Pigg seconded. All approved.
- III. Reports
  - a. President – Tammy Ebert

Tammy discussed the name changes affecting a few of our community colleges, including Coastal Alabama. She noted that there were 22 colleges represented at the annual conference. She also discussed the success of the inaugural math competition and encouraged all of the colleges represented to attend this year. - IV. New Business
  - a. Nancy Rivers – 2017 AMATYC Regional Vice President

Nancy discussed AMATYC's changing mind set at the two-year college level. She discussed websites and webinars that confirm this change, namely, Crossroads and Beyond Crossroads. IMPACT will be available at the fall 2017 conference. She also mentioned Project Access and encouraged participation in the program. The AMATYC annual conference will be held in San Diego. AMATYC will host a Student Math League competition where students can win

scholarships that will be awarded at the annual conference. If members would like to attend the conference, affiliate scholarships are available. Finally, Nancy discussed the Regional Facebook Group and encouraged participation from all members present.

b. Michael Green – 2017 Mathematics Tournament

The 2017 Mathematics Tournament will be held on October 7, 2017 at Shelton State. There will be a Calculus competition in the morning followed by a Pre-Calculus competition in the afternoon. He would like to see more participation from schools across the state.
